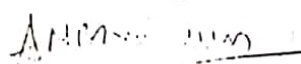

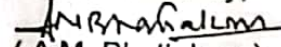

The inconvenience caused to you in this regard is regretted.

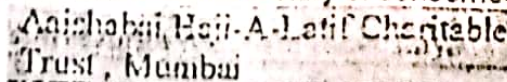
